Key Stage 2 Data 2016

2016 was the first year that pupil tests did not include levels. The results of the tests were converted to a scaled score ranging from 80 to 120. Pupils achieving a scaled score of 100 or more are said to be working at the expected standard. Pupils achieving 110 or more are classed as working at the higher standard.

Please note that these test results cannot be compared to previous years due to the more challenging demands of the current curriculum. Please also note that there were only 7 children in this cohort.
